Are you tired of paying high prices for inferior service? Are you tired of paying extra for yard waste removal? Are you tired of paying a fuel surcharge? Are you tired of paying an administration fee? If you answered yes to any of these questions, you need to sign up for the trash removal service provided by your Township.

Our customers enjoy weekly trash removal, recycling removal, yard waste removal and removal of large items (sofas, recliners, mattresses, etc.) without any additional fees or surcharges. Free access to the yard waste site is also included. We bill quarterly (every three months) and the cost is only \$49.00 per quarter. We have two sizes of totes, 64 gallons and 96 gallons. You choose the size that is right for your family. Additional totes are available for \$3 per quarter

To sign up for our service, stop in and fill out a contract or go to our website and get the form there. You can print it out and mail it in, drop it in the night deposit box or email it to us. As soon as we receive your completed contract, we will begin garbage service on the next scheduled day for your area.

Christmas and New Year's Holiday Sanitation Collection Schedule



Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve fall on a Sunday this year. Because of this, Muskegon Township will observe the following schedule:

- Township offices will be closed on December 25 & 26 for the Holidays. Sanitation and Recycling service WILL NOT run on December 25 but WILL run on December 26 and collection will be one day later than normal for the entire week.
- Township offices will be closed on January 1 & 2 for the Holidays. Sanitation service WILL NOT run on January 1 but WILL run on January 2 and collection will be one day later than normal for the entire week.

Winter Reminders

- All portable basketball equipment should be removed from the streets and/or road right-of-ways.
- The snow season is almost here, make sure all cars are removed from the street during snowy conditions. This allows the Department of Public Works' snow plows to do a great job for the community.
- Snow plows forcefully throw snow and ice chunks several feet. Make sure your mailbox is securely fastened to the post. It must be able to withstand the force of the snow from the plows. Cars parked next to the road in unpaved road right-of-ways may be damaged by debris thrown off the plow. Cars should be parked in driveways.
- Call the non-emergency number for Central Dispatch, 231-722-3524, to report water main breaks or sewer problems after normal working hours.
- Contact the Muskegon Charter Township Police Department before you leave for vacation or head south for the winter. Officers can keep an eye on your house for you while you are away. Contact the department at 231-777-2555 Ext. 1117.

Direct Debit Bill Pay

Muskegon Township offers Direct Debit Bill Pay for your Sewer, Sanitation and Tax bills. Direct debit payments allow your bill to be paid automatically from your checking or savings account via an Automated Clearing House (ACH) transaction. Sewer and Sanitation bills will be debited from your account on the due date. For Tax bills, you can specify to have your Summer Tax bill paid on the first Friday of July or the first Friday of September. Winter taxes can be paid on the first Friday in December, the last business day in December or the first Friday in February. You can discontinue direct debit payments at any time with written notice to the Township Treasurer. So, whether you are on vacation, spending winters down south or busy working around the house, you can relax knowing your bill is always paid on time.
